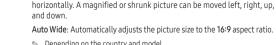

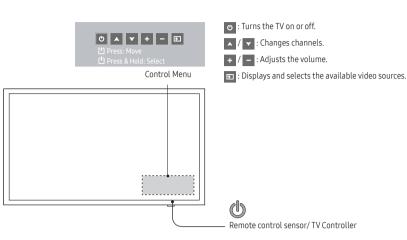
#### Turning on the TV

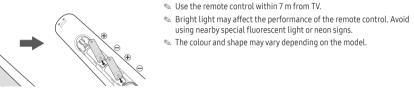

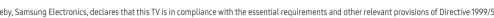

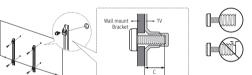
